The event began with a New Orleans-style funeral parade for Lady Liberty (complete with coffin, pall bearers, and second-line musicians performing an original composition by band leader John D'earth) making its way the length

of the Downtown Mall from Ting Pavilion. After street theater performances and songs from the Charlottesville Women's Choir and Wonderground Singers, Lady Liberty was reborn, and a jubilant *When the Saints Go Marching In* ended the parade on a high note!

A Democracy Fair with 20+ local nonprofits and political groups tabling was held concurrently; Cville Dems participated.
