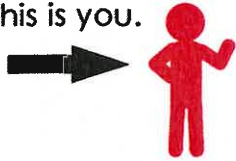


# CD5 Race for the Democratic Nod

## Caucus + Convention = Candidate

There is no primary in the 5th Congressional District in 2018. Instead, there will be a Caucus-Convention system of selecting the Democratic nominee. Here's how it works.

This is you.



### Key Takeaway:

The average person's power in this process is in showing up at the city or county caucus to vote.

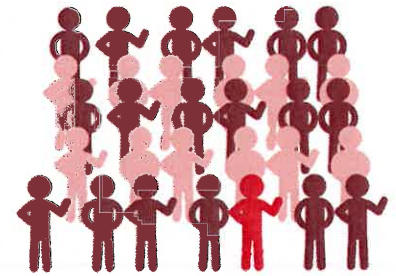
**Your body is your vote.**

### Prior to your locality's caucus, you should:

- Choose your candidate
- Plan to attend your locality's local caucus:
  - Charlottesville: April 21, 1:15pm, Burley gym
  - Albemarle Co: April 16, 5:30pm, Monticello High
- Get as many supporters of your candidate to the local city/county caucus as possible.
- If you're interested in being a delegate to the 5th District Convention, tell the campaign of the candidate you support AND file with the Chair of your local Democratic committee at least seven days before the caucus. (Voluntary \$ 5 fee)

### On the day of your locality's caucus...

- Arrive early, sign in, and gather with other supporters of your candidate. **Do NOT arrive late!**
- Candidates will speak. Supporters for each candidate will gather in groups for a final count.\*
- This count will determine the proportion of delegates to attend the CD5 convention.
- Candidates must get at least 15% of caucus delegates to send delegates to the convention.
- Supporters choose the individuals who will be the committed delegates at the CD5 convention, emphasizing gender balance in delegate selection.



Hey look, you and lots of others are voting for your candidate at the county caucus!

### A Hypothetical:

Your locality (County X) sends 20 delegates to the CD5 convention based on the formula already set by the CD5 committee. On the day of your locality's caucus, 200 people show up.

Candidate 1 gets 70 votes, Candidate 2 gets 50 votes, Candidate 3 & Candidate 4 get 40 votes each.

Who goes to the convention as a voting delegate?

Supporters of Candidate 1 select 7 delegates  
Supporters of Candidate 2 select 5 delegates.  
Supporters of Candidate 3 select 4 delegates  
Supporters of Candidate 4 select 4 delegates.



You've been selected as a delegate for Candidate 1 from County X

The results of the locality caucuses throughout the 5th District will show the relative strength of each candidate going into the convention.

\*Note: a caucus delegate CAN caucus as **uncommitted** or for **no candidate**. Though these are unlikely to reach 15% in this year's contested race.
