Fellows play a key role in the campaign. Each fellow's responsibilities and tasks will vary based on expertise, area of interest, and campaign priorities. There are fellowships available in several departments: field, finance, and digital.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Field
 - Engaging in political messaging and persuasion conversations with voters through door-to-door canvassing and phone calls
 - Recruiting and developing relationships with volunteers and executing volunteer-led phone banks and canvasses
 - Basic logic of electoral organizing and how organizing programs are developed
- Digital
 - Schedule management
 - Develop social media content
 - Document campaign activities through video and photography
- Finance
 - Donor research
 - Staff and manage fundraising events

SCHEDULE

Fellows must work a minimum of 10 hours per week. The fellowship is unpaid but we are happy to comply with any necessary paperwork for course credit. Applicants should have a laptop and cell phone.

- A team player, passionate about Leslie's priorities – health care, the environment, education, women, the economy, criminal justice policy
- Work or live in Virginia's 5th congressional district
