# YES!

Just bring in your mail in ballot  
when you go to the polls!

To cast a ballot, you must either provide an acceptable ID OR sign an ID confirmation statement attesting to your identity.

## ACCEPTABLE TYPES OF ID CARDS



FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCALLY ISSUED ID

STUDENT ID

EMPLOYER ID

CURRENT UTILITY BILL, BANK STATEMENT,  
GOVERNMENT CHECK, PAYCHECK, OR OTHER  
GOVERNMENT DOCUMENT CONTAINING  
YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS

**IF YOU'RE 17 BUT TURN 18 BEFORE ELECTION DAY, CAN YOU REGISTER TO VOTE?**

BEGINNING ON OCTOBER 1ST, ANY PERSON WHO IS 16 YEARS OF AGE

OR OLDER, BUT WHO WILL NOT BE 18 YEARS OF AGE

ON OR BEFORE THE DAY OF THE NEXT GENERAL ELECTION, MAY PREREGISTER TO VOTE.
